

New Recycling Program at Vida

Effective Monday, December 21, 2009, owners, renters and guests are able to recycle their aluminum, glass, plastic, and paper (cardboard) waste material. A portion of the revenue generated from the recycled materials will be paid to Vida Del Mar and will be used to make contributions to the Naranjo Middle School (next to the clinic on the Vida Del Mar road) and the Vida Employees Assistance Fund.

This is an exciting opportunity to do the right thing while doing a good thing. Recycling serves the environmental interests of our community while being a witness to sound waste management principles. The resulting revenue, while modest, also permits the Association to enrich the lives of our neighbors and our employees when they have unanticipated needs.

How do I participate?

You separate your recyclable material into four categories of waste: aluminum, glass, plastic, and paper putting each in to the proper container in the drop area. The drop area is located on the office side of the main entrance road just past the guard station as you enter Vida.

Is there a particular time when I need to drop off my materials?

You may drop off your recyclables at any time. The material will be picked up every Friday afternoon. Should the volume of material recycled warrant doing so; more frequent pick ups will be established.

Is this a volunteer program?

Yes. While we hope that all Vida owners will avail themselves of this new service, waste will continue to be picked up as is currently the case at all authorized waste stations.
